- The usable space is approximately 13,000 square fee (6,500 Sq. Feet each floor)
- · Three offices.
- Two standard size classrooms.
- It has 16 cubical rooms for girls.
- Total number of girls that can use this facility is 200 girls.
- Total number of classrooms are 2 classes.
- One Multipurpose hall included to be used as a laboratory.
- It has a total of 22 washrooms.
- The water tank of 154,000 liters.
- It has Terance roof of 6,000 square feet, veranda and corridors
- Entire construction is anticipated to be completed by the end of February.
